

We've turned the corner and are now ready to resume our historic level of Masonic activity. This applies to all bodies that meet in the Building, which is now available for outside rental again. Only a few ritual modifications will continue until September. We're now able to serve meals in the usual fashion and are looking forward eagerly to our first pancake breakfast since March of 2020. Those of you who didn't make the meal at the May stated missed out on an outstanding meal of Peruvian chicken. We hope you'll join us this month.

As we all celebrate the return to normalcy, please remember we may have Brethren who have health issues or loved ones with compromised immune systems. We should not make anyone feel uncomfortable who is hesitant about coming out or who still chooses to wear a mask. That's a matter left up to each Brother.

Looking ahead, we'll be planning several events to bring everyone back together and reenergize ourselves. As stated last month, we're planning a Lodge picnic on August 21st back at the Isaac Walton League and a Table Lodge on Saturday, September 18th. This will not be our September stated, but will instead be a special called communication. A flier for the Golf tournament September 24th is attached to this Trestle Board. In addition to players, we need sponsors and prizes to make this a successful fundraising event. We're also planning some additional family events, as well as an outing for our widows this fall. This month's stated meeting theme will be Youth Night, featuring both the Job's Daughters and Rainbow Girls, with a program before Lodge formally opens. The proceeds from this month's charity basket will go to the SPCA, one of the Rainbow charities. This is a great opportunity for those of you who may have daughters, granddaughters, or nieces, to learn what these organizations are about and get a petition. We will also have a representative from the DeMolay.

I also want to update you on the columbarium project as well as building projects at the Lodge. We have done some preliminary survey work and identified several locations with possible graves or markers where we don't have records. You may have noticed flags scattered around the cemetery. Within the next couple months, we're planning on doing a more thorough survey with ground-penetrating radar, which could impact the feasibility of the project. The findings will be reported back to the Lodge in a future meeting. Regardless of the outcome, both the cemetery and building are in need of repairs and we need to be very proactive in preserving these for future generations. We are also undertaking some remodeling, including expanding the Secretary's and Treasurer's offices into the front, formerly William Moseley Brown, room. Bro. Shawn Bryar is also redesigning the Lodge foyer to make it a more visually impressive entryway. This room, designed to showcase our Lodge's history, will be christened the Lafayette Room.

Lastly, let us pause this Memorial Day to remember those who paid the ultimate sacrifice in the defense of our great country and the God-given liberties we enjoy.

The Lodge would like to congratulate R.W. Jeff VacCuren, PM, on his upcoming installation as Grand Master in the Grand Lodge of South Dakota, A.F. & A.M, on Friday, June 18th, 2021.

Our Chaplain, Bro. Shawn Bryar, has recently undertaken an effort to renovate the Lodge foyer, in an 18th Century French style. There were three antique fireplace mantels in the Lodge attic, collecting dust and grime from time immemorial. The largest and most elaborate of the three was removed, power washed, sanded, and painted by Bro. Bryar. Shown below are the before and after pictures.





The Lodge will commemorate the Bicentenntial of Gen. and Brother Lafayette's visit to Fredericksburg in 2024. Our historian, Wor. Shelby Chandler, participated in a virtual seminar held by The Lafayette Trail, Inc. at Cincinnati-Lafayette Lodge No. 483 in Cincinnati, OH, the night of our May stated. At his visit in November 1824, Bro. Lafayette was made an honorary member of Fredericksburg Lodge No. 4.



As a centerpiece of the new Lafayette Room, the Lodge will display this Louis XVI-style *vitrine*, or glass display cabinet, featuring ornate decorative *ormolu* work. This was donated to the Lodge by Bro. Robert J. Breitenbach and his wife Deborah L. Breitenbach, in the name of Bro. James H. R. Curd and his wife, Betty L. Curd.




