

Hello, Brethren! March is upon us. Spring is in the air (I hope so anyway). I want to take a moment to recognize an effort currently driven by Worshipful Jamie Snyder and Carrie Morton Combs. Years ago (I think during Most Worshipful Jeff VanCuren's year as Worshipful Master), Lodge No. 4 started opening the Lodge to community groups that would come in to serve meals to our un-housed neighbors and others in need. We still host Oak Grove Baptist Church's community meal on the 2nd Tuesday of every month.

Over time, Lodge No. 4 took over providing meals on the 5th Tuesday of the month when they come around. The last meal was on Tuesday January 30, 2024. Through the efforts of Worshipful Jamie and Carrie, 15 community groups, including Lodge No. 4, came together to either volunteer or donate food for the meal. 105 individual meals were served to a mix of men, women, teenagers, and even military veterans. In addition, donations of clothing, hand-knitted hats, 200 pairs of socks and some military surplus items were donated and quickly claimed by those in attendance.

These meals have a significant positive impact for those served. Our efforts are being noticed in our community and are made worth it when attendees express their gratitude. That gratitude and the passion which volunteers bring to each meal are contagious. I hope more Brothers at Lodge No. 4 can volunteer to experience that! The next 5th Tuesday meal is on July 30, 2024. 
