

### Secretary's Corner

Brethren, this month is Founder's Day Month, which recognizes the founding of the Grand Lodge of Virginia on October 30, 1778 in Williamsburg, as well as the Masonic Home of Virginia in 1890. Our Lodge was one of the founding Lodges and our own M.W. James Mercer, who would go on to become the second Grand Master in 1785, was president of the convention that led to formation of the Grand Lodge. We recognize the debt we owe to our founders this month.

There have been some questions about dues payments for next year. Our dues-paying members should expect to get an invoice around November. A reminder that dues are due the first of January. Please take a moment to make sure your correct mailing address and email and phone number are on file with the Lodge.

A couple months ago, I talked about the duties of the Secretary. This month, I'd ask you to consider the Tiler. His is largely a thankless job, relegated to the outer courts while we go about our work and business. Thankfully it is now automatic that he be allowed to sit in the doorway except at opening and closing, balloting, and Degree work. The Installation Ceremony says that his presence is a 'constant admonition...to set a guard at the entrance of our thoughts, to place a watch at the door of our lips, and to post a sentinel at the avenue of our actions, thereby excluding every unqualified and unworthy thought, word, and deed.' It is particularly important to remain mindful of this in our spoken and written communications, especially in our email interactions and posts, which leave a permanent record and can be easily misconstrued, remembering that silence and circumspection are truly Masonic virtues.
